To be added as a joint owner, you will need to bring a copy of your child's birth certificate or social security card, as well as two forms of ID for yourself.

You will need to bring in one of the following:

- Driver's License
- State Issued ID
- Passport
- Alien Identification Card

You will also need to bring one from the following:

- Insurance Card with name
- Social Security Card
- Debit or Credit Card with name
- Employee ID Card
- Utility Bill with current address

By signing below you, the parent/guardian, acknowledge all information provided above is accurate. You also understand by not being a joint owner on the account, you have no rights on the account or access to the funds. You also give authorization to be contacted via text, email, or phone.

To help the government fight the funding of terrorism and money laundering activities, Federal law requires all financial institutions to obtain, verify, and record information identifying each person opening an account. What this means to you: This information sheet must be filled out completely in order to verify your information and open your account. We must be able to identify the person (student) requesting the account. We must have the deposit required to open an account. If you are joining the credit union and opening a savings account, the minimum deposit is \$5. Once your account is opened, the credit union will send you all federally required disclosures.
